## AN ACT

To create the “2011-2012 Budget Support Fund” under the custody of the Office of Management and Budget; provide for the allocation of nineteen million ~~seven hundred~~ two hundred fifty-two thousand dollars (~~\$19,752,000~~) (\$19,252,000) from this Fund to various government agencies as itemized in Section 6 [sic] of this Act; authorize the contracting of works; authorize the matching of funds; and for other purposes.

### ***BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF PUERTO RICO:***

Section 1.- Establishment of the Fund – the 2011-2012 Budget Support Fund is hereby created under the custody of the Office of Management and Budget.

Section 2.- This Fund may receive legislative, municipal, Federal, or private appropriations and the matching or combination of said funds shall be allowed.

Section 3.- To begin its operations, the Fund shall receive an initial appropriation of eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) from the Insurance Industry Supervision and Regulation Fund; an appropriation of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) from the Special Telecommunications Regulatory Board Fund; and an appropriation of six million ~~seven hundred~~ two hundred fifty-two thousand dollars (~~\$6,752,000~~) (\$6,252,000) from the Fund for the Investigation and Audit of Financial Institutions and Gambling Casinos.

Section 4.- The sum of nineteen million ~~seven hundred~~ two hundred fifty-two thousand dollars (~~\$19,752,000~~) (\$19,252,000) originating from the 2011-2012 Budget Support Fund shall be allocated to various government agencies as itemized below:

Section 5.- Any appropriation originating from this Fund, or any surplus therefrom as a result of a line veto by the Governor, or any available amount, shall be appropriated by means of Joint Resolutions approved by the Legislative Assembly. It is herein established that this provision shall not be violated by any Governing Board or by any other instrumentality or entity of the government.

Section 6.- Entering into contract with municipal governments and private contractors, as well as with any department, agency, or corporation of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to achieve the purposes of Section 6 [sic] of this Act is hereby authorized.

Section 7.—The funds appropriated under Section 6 [sic] of this Act may be matched with Federal, Commonwealth, and/or municipal funds.

Section 8.—This Act shall take effect immediately after its approval.
